## Smell Gas? Act Fast!

Residents are the first line of defense when it come to leak detection. Utilities odorize natural gas with Mercaptan-which smells similar to rotten egg-so that it's easy to smell if there is a gas leak. If you detect a gas leak, take action immediately.

- 1. Leave the building immediately and take others with you. If you are outside when you smell the gas, leave the area immediately.
- 2. Avoid causing a spark, which might cause the gas to explode:
  - 1. Do not light a match or smoke.
  - 2. Do not turn appliances or light on or off.
  - 3. Do not use a flashlight.
  - 4. Do not start a car.
  - 5. Do not use a phone.
- 3. Find a phone away from the area and call 911 or your natural gas utility. You can report leaks anonymously. Always call to report the problem. Do not assume someone else will do it.
- 4. Follow directions from utility employees or emergency responders who are on site.

If you are uncomfortable with the slightest smell of gas call the administrative office during office hours or maintenance emergency phone number so that we can check it. Better to be safe. Piedmont Natural Gas number is 1-800-752-

## Drain stop ups.....

When maintenance is called out for a stopped up kitchen sink, bathroom sink or bathtub most of the time it requires an augur to be used to unstop the clog. Many times maintenance finds the cause of the stop up. Most times in the kitchen sink it is due to grease or food being poured into the sink. This grease will get cold in the pipes and will cause everything to get backed up in the sink. Save a coffee can or a grease can to pour your grease in. In the bathroom sink the stop ups are usually caused by hair in the sink. Also, the bathtub stop ups are usually caused by hair. If you keep your drain free of hair you will not have any problems. As for commodes most times it is due to flushable wipes. Just because the package says they are flushable does not mean that they are. They will really clog up a toilet. Just remember not grease, food , hair or wipes and your drains should remain clog



#### **HVAC Units**

Units at McKay, Washington and Harnett Terrace are what is called a Heat Pump. In the winter when the weather is cold the unit will come on and blow air which is not hot, but is warming up the system up to come on again and blow your really warm air. I get calls saying my heat is blowing cold air and sometimes it is not cold air it is just the cooler air blowing to warm up the unit. If it continuously blows cool air then call maintenance to come check the unit.
